His dedication to qaseeda writing and his role in Talabulilm highlight his commitment to both personal and communal growth. As a proud father and avid traveler, he finds joy in exploring new cultures and cherishing moments with his son. His life blends spiritual devotion with a passion for creativity and a deep love for nature.

During his early childhood, Mehlam BS Burhani's father's engineering career took the family to various parts of the world, including the United States, the United Kingdom, al-Moizziyat al-Qaherah, and eventually Mumbai, India.

His mother, Sarrah BS, grew up in Saifee Mahal and was known for her involvement in community upliftment projects. Her talents in flower arrangement and interior decoration left a lasting impact on his creativity. His grandmother, Shehzadi Maryam bs, the daughter of Syedna Taher Saifuddin, was especially fond of him. She lovingly called him "popat" because of her love for nature and birds, particularly parrots. She inspired his passion for voice and qaseeda writing. This nickname, "popat," is also fondly known by Syedna Mufaddal Saifuddin TUS.

Growing up in Saifee Mahal, he was blessed to be in the presence of al-Dai al-Ajal Syedna Mohammed Burhanuddin RA and his Mansoos, al-Dai al-Ajal Syedna Mufaddal Saifuddin TUS. Burhanuddin Maula had many pet names for him, such as "Chhoto Mehlam" and "Professor," making his childhood feel starry and blessed. This special affection from Maula meant the world to him, and today, Syedna Mufaddal Saifuddin TUS continues to show him the same love and affection. He is extremely grateful for these blessings.

He is a proud father of a 12-year-old son, and spending time with him brings him immense joy. They enjoy playing together, exploring new activities, and growing up side by side. His son is his world, and their time together is filled with laughter, learning, and love.

He has always loved writing qaseedas and presenting them to his Maula at every opportunity, seeking a smile, which meant everything to him. Even today, he continues to write qaseedas, and Maula TUS always appreciates them, gifting him his smile—his greatest passion in life. This skill earned a significant place in Syedna Mohammed Burhanuddin's eyes, who would sometimes inquire, "Wo choto Mehlaam kaha che?" or say, "Qaseedoh nathi likho?" He always appreciated this skill, saying, "Qaseedah acha likhe che, ane ghana likhe che."

He studied at al-Jamea tus Saifiyah and attained the Faqeeh al-Jayyed Degree. He is also fortunate to have received the degree of Hifz al-Quran al-Kareem from Mahad al-Zahra, signed by both Syedna Mohammed Burhanuddin RA and Syedna Mufaddal Saifuddin TUS.

Upon completing his studies, he was honored with the opportunity to lead the newly established Janah al-Tarannum, a Vocal Development and Audio Production House at al-Jamea tus Saifiyah. He has worked in this department to foster a culture of professional recitation in all Dawat-e-Hadiyah congregations.

For the past 25 years, he and his team have produced a series of audio albums called Sautuliman, which has now reached its heights after more than 45 years of legacy. Additionally, he serves as the director of Idarat al-Zakereen, an organization dedicated to the development, training, and management of zakereen worldwide. Over the past two years, in addition to his role at Idarat al-Zakereen, he has been the principal of Rawdat al-Quran al-Kareem in Mumbai, a primary and secondary school managed by al-Jamea tus Saifiyah. This unique school, established by Syedna Mufaddal Saifuddin TUS, revolves around the teachings of the Quran. It offers a comprehensive curriculum, from science to English, all in the light of the Quran, and teaches in Arabic, English, and Hindi. It is remarkable to see students as young as those in pre-primary understanding and speaking Arabic by the time they reach grades two and three. The school's hands-on, experiential learning approach, aligned with Cambridge standards, creates a vibrant and energetic environment filled with enthusiastic young minds.

Before joining Rawdat al-Quran, he also served as a director in Talabulilm for 10 years. This department of Dawat-e-Hadiyah is responsible for guiding and assisting Dawoodi Bohra students worldwide who are pursuing higher education. The mission was to help them excel in their academic and professional pursuits, ensuring they became worthy of serving mankind according to the guidance and teachings of Awliya Kiraam. He, along with his learned colleagues, helped establish this department under the patronage of Sadaat Kiraam, which today runs smoothly and effectively.

He has a deep passion for traveling and considers it his favorite hobby. He has been fortunate to have explored many incredible places and dreams of visiting every country someday, Inshallah. He enjoys sports like golf, skiing, and horse riding and finds joy in nature's beauty, whether it's lush meadows, refreshing rains, or sandy beaches. Discovering new cultures and foods makes him grateful for the world's diversity. 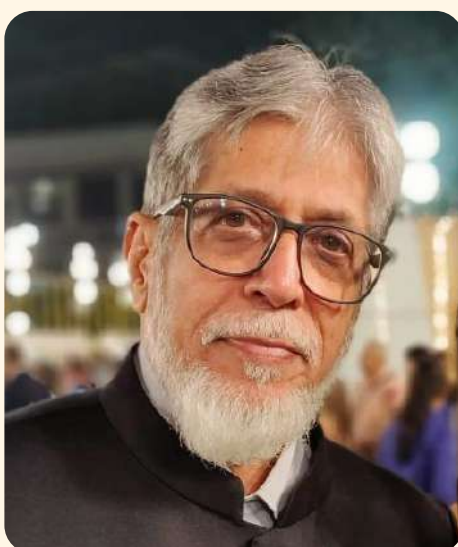
He also believes that technology is the main stay in better deliverance health care and proficiency in technology is equally important to proficiency in clinical aspects.

In Saifee Hospital he started his career as an Assistant Director and is currently the Chief Executive Officer.

SHK HUSSAIN BHAI NALWALA

In the words of Mother Teresa, "We know only too well that what we are doing is nothing more than a drop in the ocean. But if the drop were not there, the ocean would be missing something." Our guest of honor Shk Hussain Bhai Nalwala has been selflessly filling up this very ocean with multitude acts of generosity over the past several years.

Shk Hussain bhai, born and brought up in Mumbai, relocated to Dubai about 30 years ago. They currently own manufacturing facilities that produce construction chemicals, which not only have an excellent market in the Middle East, but also export to over 80 countries.



During the pandemic, on being asked to remain at home by his son to avoid exposure, he got involved in doing charitable work in Mumbai, Dubai and other parts of the world. He had a tie-up with a local caterer in Mumbai and they began distributing a sizeable amount of cooked food to whosoever required it, irrespective of which community they belonged to, as in his words, "it was the need to the hour".

Since the construction industry was affected quite badly during the pandemic, several labor camps were suffering from acute food shortages as they were not being paid their wages. Shk Hussain bhai began regularly distributing food supplies to these camps to support them in whichever way he could. His charitable acts became so well-known that the Indian Consulate approached him to help repatriate 37 people stranded in Dubai jails back to their homes in Andhra Pradesh.

On retiring, Shk Hussain bhai realised that this office was being managed quite efficiently by his staff without him, and hence he focused all his energies towards continuing on with his charitable endeavours. After working with orphanages and old age homes for a considerable time, he set up an old age home which currently houses 28-30 residents absolutely free of cost. They are provided with 5 meals per day, along with weekly doctor visits. In case of emergencies, the home has a tie-up with a nearby hospital. Additionally, he also set up a dialysis centre on the ground floor of the old age home which charges only a fraction (Rs. 150) of what is otherwise charged elsewhere (Rs. 1500-2500).

Shk Hussain bhai has also been quite active in Kashmir, helping out those in need with providing education, food supplies and housing.

We are honoured to have him attend our event. May he continue to inspire people all around him with his philanthropic acts.

KEY HIGHLIGHTS – ACCOUNTS

1. The financial year 2023-24 was again a robust year for the Trust where the Trust conducted several activities of social causes which included organising on Urus Mubarak **blood donation camp, highly subsidised blood tests, free medical check-ups and doctor consultations to people** from various faiths/backgrounds, awarding **scholarships to students**, sponsorship for **free monthly FMB Thalís and Free Anaaj Distribution** to the needy from different ethnicity in and around Khambat during the Holy month of Ramzan H.1445, **surgery crowd funding for cancer treatment, medical and business working capital assistance** etc. All these activities were only possible with the **donations received to the tune of close to Rs. 24.50 Lacs** from our generous donors. Jazak Allah Khair to our donors for their kind hearted patronage.
2. **URUS MAJLIS AND JAMAN:** The Annual Urus Majlis and Jaman witnessed an overwhelming participation of nearly **525 guests**. The Trust spent **Rs. 4,53,953/-** on the pious event. This was possible from hoob collections especially from few large amount Hoob donors who came forward generously to participate in this pious Sawaab. May Allah bestow His abundance on our Donors. Ameen!!
3. **SOUVENIR:** The Trust collected **Rs. 1,42,050/- from 53 advertisements** this year; down from **Rs. 1,62,051/- from 62 advertisements** collected last year. A big thank you to our dear advertisers for the patronage and we Trustees wish you multitude success in your ventures.

4. SCHOLARSHIP:

- a. In comparison to the previous financial year where donations received towards scholarship amounted to only Rs. 1,87,190/-; this year the Trust received an overwhelming amount of Rs. **5,01,286/-**. The Trust awarded scholarships aggregating to Rs. **3,96,000/-** to **29 deserving students up from 20 students in last year.**
- b. The Trust awarded **2 meritorious students with 1gm gold coins each.**
- c. Further, the Trust **spent Rs. 10,000/- in conducting career guidance counselling sessions** at Mohammedi Mohalla Masjid which were attended by several students from higher grades.

The Trustees wish the students a bright and promising future through the education they deserve.

5. MEDICAL AND GENERAL WELFARE:

a. MEDICAL:

- i. The Trust **successfully conducted a blood donation camp, highly subsidised blood tests home and camp sample collection which was followed by free medical check-ups and doctor consultations on the day of Urus H.1445.** Hundreds of people from various backgrounds took advantage and attended these sessions which saw doctors from various faculties providing free medical check-ups and free consultations. A CPR training was also conducted for the attendees which could prove to be a life saver in case of medical emergencies.
- ii. The Trust **facilitated and provided medical assistance of nearly Rs. 57,000/- towards surgery for removal of a painful bone cyst of a teenage daughter of a Khambati family.** The surgery was **conducted at Saifee Hospital, Mumbai** and it brought a lot of relief from pain to the patient. Few of our Trustee members also visited the patient at the hospital to see her back to good recovery.
- iii. The Trust's efforts were instrumental in crowd funding to support surgery cost for Cancer treatment in case of a senior citizen. The Trust paid Rs. **1,75,000/-** for the cancer treatment which provided a much needed relief to the family of the patient.

b. GENERAL:

- i. The Trust **sponsored and organized free full day meals at an Old Age Home near Khambat.** The Old Age Home provides shelter and food to nearly **100 Old Aged people from different background and ethnicity** not having anyone of their own to take care of them. The Trust **organized occasions of birthday or any celebrations/wish of the sponsor** where full day three meals and evening tea with snacks were served. Sessions of games and singing were organized by our Trust members where the people participated.
- ii. The Trust also **organized lunch program with games to around 100 Children in Khambat** coming from under privileged backgrounds. **This was organized to celebrate birthday of the sponsor's 14 year aged son.**
- iii. The Trust also **provided business working capital assistance of Rs. 10,000/- to a needy old aged Khambati** selling his wares at traffic signal junctions. The assistance helped the person obtain more stock at lesser price thereby increasing his profits in the long run.

6. RAMZAN-H.1445

- a. **ANAAJ DISTRIBUTION IN KHAMBAT:** During this event, the Trust like last year distributed nearly **5,300 kgs of food grains and grocery to nearly 450 needy families in and around Khambat** in various talukas and districts from different faiths and backgrounds.
- b. **FMB THALI SPONSORSHIP IN KHAMBAT:** During this event, in collaboration of the Khambat Jamaat, the Trust sponsored FMB Thalís for **31 needy families in Khambat ranging for different period of months and amounts.**

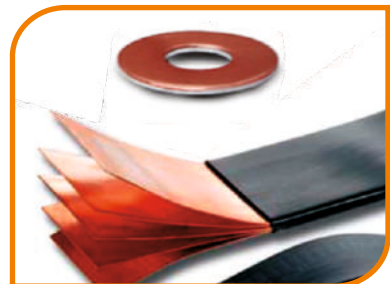
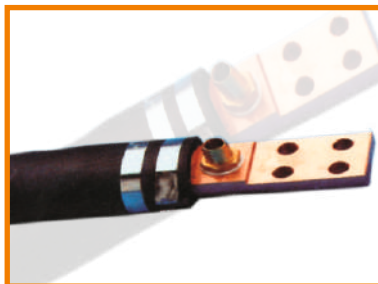

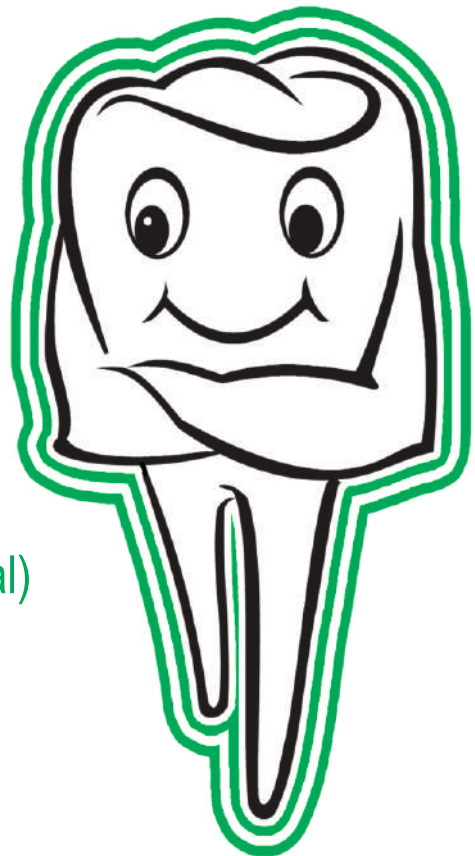

Restoring Vision, Renewing Hope:

The Impact of the 37th Free Eye Camp at Cambay General Hospital

"A man's true wealth is the good he does in the world." This sentiment echoed profoundly at the **37th Free Eye Camp**, held from January 12-15, 2024, at Cambay General Hospital in Khambhat. Organized with a vision to bring clarity and smiles to faces, the camp was a testament to the community's commitment to well-being.

The camp was organized by LT SASD, Jhunjhunwala foundation, Health first trust, Beyond Vision, and was led by *Dr. Shk. Mustafa Parekh* and *Dr. Nimesh Jain*, a well known ophthalmologist from Galiyakot, conducted comprehensive cataract surgeries. Two eye camps were held—one at Khambhat Jamat Khana and the other at Cambay General Hospital. With over **700** outpatient visits (OPDs) from the rural areas of Khambhat and Anand, the medical team successfully performed **124 cataract surgeries** over four days.

One of the most remarkable aspects of this camp was its ability to treat patients who had been turned away by other doctors due to their complex medical histories. Patients like Hamida Ben and Babubhai Miradiya from Kauka, who suffered from uncontrolled asthma, hypertension, and heart issues, were successfully operated on, restoring their vision and improving their quality of life. 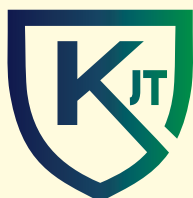

PROJECT – CARDIOPULMONARY RESUSCITATION (CPR) TALK & DEMO ON URS FUNCTION AT ZAINEE HALL.

03/SEPT/2023



In today's fast paced world, where people are under stress for small things which can lead to dire health issues, taking care and being aware of emergency care is important.

With that in mind, we had organised a talk on Cardiopulmonary resuscitation (CPR), a lifesaving technique that's useful in Cardiac arrest (many emergencies), in which someone's breathing or heartbeat has stopped.

The talk was delivered by **Ms.Sumaiya Raghavan - Operations Head from Revive Heart Foundation (iCARE) Holy Family Hospital Mumbai**, who is a qualified trainer on First Aid Heart saving and CPR certification from the American Heart Association.

iCARE have held numerous workshops on how to handle cardiac arrest emergencies and have trained over 200,000 citizens including the front line force and workers of the country in the last 6 years that include Police Personnel, Railway officials and Fire fighters of various states.

Ms Sumaiya started her session by involving the participants who were present, asking them what they knew of heart attack and cardiac arrest and what are their symptoms. A good no. of our members participated and attentive.

It was an eye-opening session for everyone present and gave insight on the Do's and Don'ts of a cardiac emergency. Below, we share excerpts from the talk -

Heart attack - A heart attack occurs when an artery that sends blood and oxygen to the heart is blocked.

Common heart attack symptoms include:

- Chest pain that may feel like pressure, tightness, pain, squeezing or aching
- Pain or discomfort that spreads to the shoulder, arm, back, neck, jaw, teeth or sometimes the upper belly
- Cold sweat, Fatigue, Heartburn or indigestion
- Light-headedness or sudden dizziness, Nausea, Shortness of breath

Cardiac arrest is a sudden and unexpected loss of heart function. During cardiac arrest, the heart stops pumping blood to the body and brain, leading to rapid loss of consciousness and breathing.

Symptoms of cardiac arrest:

- Sudden collapse,
- No pulse.
- No breathing.
- Loss of consciousness.
- Sometimes other symptoms may occur before sudden cardiac arrest, such as chest discomfort, shortness of breath, weakness, or palpitations.
- However, sudden cardiac arrest often occurs with no warning.

Once the symptoms are observed, an immediate intervention, **Cardiopulmonary resuscitation (CPR)** can be used to revive the patient till medical help is reached.

Ms. Sumaiya along with her staff demonstrated how to do CPR and also called upon the participants to volunteer and try the technique on a dummy they had got. It was indeed an experiential learning, one of its kind in Anjuman E Abdullah Khambhat Trust's Urs function.

CAMBAY (KHAMBHAT)

HISTORIC FACT : FROM COLONIALISM TO COMMERCE (FROM THE BOOKS OF HISTORY)

Khambhat, previously known as Cambay can be spotted in historic book written by Arabic traveler- Al Masudi who landed at this port in 915 AD. Marco Polo visited Khambhat in 1293. In the year 1340, Ibn Batuta, the globally known Moroccan traveler had visited this port city. When Afanasy Nikitin, a Russian horse-dealer seeking to make his fortune, arrived in India in the year 1468, his first glimpse of the country was at Khambhat. While he eventually made his way to a port further south, he left Khambhat impressed with what he had seen. The place was a thriving port town with an international reputation. In 1440, Italian traveler Niccolo de Conti visited Khambhat and wrote about the town in his manuscripts saying the walls of Khambhat were twelve miles long. Now known as the Kothi gateway, the same wall, is believed to be built in the 1330s during the Tughlaq period

What are the historical roots of Khambhat Or the History of Khambhat?

Several famous travelers wrote about Khambhat's existence and its popular port back in books. A pictorial proof of Cambay was found in a 16th-century Portuguese manuscript which is at the Casanatense Library at present. From Khambhat's diverse culture where both Hindu and Muslims dwelled peacefully to the buzz of the Cambay port, everything about the town impressed the travelers visiting from various corners of the world.

For a period of some six centuries-from the late tenth to the sixteenth century A.D. -Khambhat was the premier port of western India. Positioned at the interface between northern India and the Indian Ocean trading network, Khambhat was not only a transit point for commodities from both areas but also a production site in its own right and a major center of Muslim patronage of architecture and fine marble carving. This article examines the production of marble carvings for Muslim patrons at the port of Khambhat and its seaborne export to patrons around the Indian Ocean , from East Africa to eastern Asia.

The remains of what has been described as a huge lost city may force historians and archaeologists to radically reconsider their view of ancient human history. Marine scientists say archaeological remains discovered 36 meters (120 feet) underwater in the Gulf of Cambay off the western coast of India could be over 9,000 years old.

The vast city - which is five miles long and two miles wide - is believed to predate the oldest known remains in the subcontinent by more than 5,000 years.

The Indian Minister for Human Resources and Ocean Development said a group had been formed to oversee further studies in the area.

Some more interesting historic facts....

Historians believe that Lieutenant Clement Downing's experience of playing the game in Cambay in the early 18th century is the first instance of cricket being played in India. Downing, in his 1737 book, *A Compendious History of Indian Wars* has the first reference of the bat and ball game being played by sailors and watched by coolies in Cambay.

Members of the East India Company fleet first played cricket during their halt at Cambay. Downing in his historic book writes that he and his fleet played the game during their stopover in Cambay as a leisure activity and people around the port came to see it.

Almost two centuries after this first instance of cricket being played on Indian soil, the country's team played its debut Test match in 1932, between Indian and English teams.

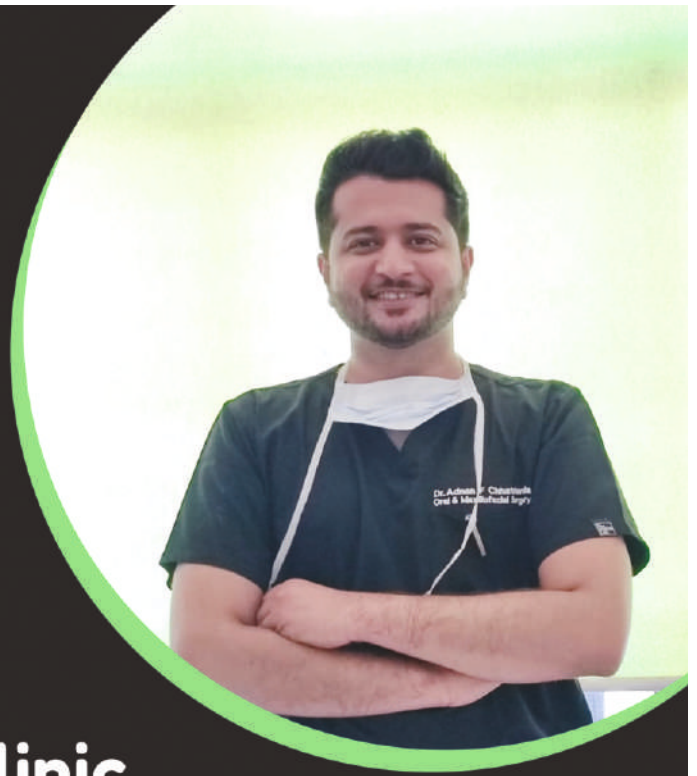
